USER INSTRUCTIONS

Congratulations on your new MYERS grinder system. With proper care and by following a few simple guidelines, your grinder pump will give you years of dependable service.

General Information

In order to provide you with suitable wastewater disposal, your home is serviced by a low pressure sewer system. The key

element in this system is the MYERS grinder pump. The tank collects all raw sewage from the house. The solids materials are then ground into a fine slurry to be pumped to the wastewater treatment line or disposal plant.

Care and Use for the MYERS Grinder Pump

The MYERS grinder pump is capable of accepting and pumping a wide range of materials found in domestic sewage. Regulatory agencies advise the following items should not be introduced into any sewer either directly or through a kitchen waste disposal unit:

Glass

Metal

Baby wipes, disinfectant wipes, moist wipes

Plastic of any kind (toys, utensils, etc.)

Sanitary napkins, tampons or condoms

Seafood shells, nut shells, or egg shells

Coffee grounds

Diapers, rags, clothing, towels, etc.

Napkins, paper towels, facial tissues, etc.

Toilet bowl scrub pads

Cat litter

Dental floss

Hair (human or pet)

Food items containing seeds and peelings

Vitamins, medicines or pharmaceuticals

In addition, you must NEVER introduce into any sewer:

Explosives

Flammable material

Oil or grease

Strong chemical (household, etc.)

Gasoline

Paint thinner

Aquarium stones

Periods of Disuse

With the MYERS grinder pump, there are no problems or special instructions needed if you leave your home unoccupied for a period of time.

Periodic Maintenance

We recommend removing the cover twice a year and hosing down the inside of the station to remove any grease or debris from the station walls or level controls.

Open the control panel door 3 or 4 times a year and check to see that there are no alarm lights on.

CAUTION: DO NOT DISCONNECT POWER TO THE UNIT

Power Failure

Your grinder pump cannot dispose of wastewater without electrical power. If electric power is interrupted, keep water usage to a minimum.

Pump Failure Alarm

Your MYERS System is provided with an alarm that will signal in the event of a high water level in the basin. This provides adequate warning to the user that service is required. During the interim prior to the arrival of authorized service personnel, water usage must be limited.
